Years of Economic Development

Funding for AEDC prior to 1998 came solely from local investors, which greatly limited the assistance the organization could provide to local businesses. In fact, before

1998, the organization often had less than \$20,000 each year to support economic development.

Businesses & Organizations Served

One of the first projects AEDC supported was gifting two lots to Boone County Hospital for a helicopter pad. Since then, our organization has built partnerships to bring in businesses, such

as Shopko Hometown, provided funding for developing housing, downtown improvements like new awnings and signage, and much more.

Years of LB 840 Funds

Since 1998, LB 840 has allowed a portion of local sales tax to support AEDC. This includes onequarter-cent city sales tax. Every 10 years, local voters cast their ballot to decide whether or not to continue this funding. Without it, AEDC would once again be very limited on how it can benefit the Albion community.
